

Attention & Working Memory in People with Schizophrenia

What is the purpose of the research?

To better understand the problems that people with schizophrenia have with concentration, memory, and problem-solving.

Who can participate?

This study is accepting men and women who:

- Are 18 to 55 years of age
- Are in good physical health
- Have a current diagnosis of Schizophrenia or Schizoaffective Disorder.

Healthy volunteers who have no mental illness are also needed for this study

What will participants be asked to do?

The study usually consists of 3 – 4 visits, each visit is lasting approximately 1-3 hours.

Participants will typically:

- Complete paper and pencil tasks and questionnaires
- Complete computer-based thinking tasks.

Where is the study taking place?

The MPRC-ORP research facility, located on the Spring Grove Hospital Center Campus in Catonsville, Maryland

How much does it cost?

There is no cost for participation.

Will I receive payment of some kind?

All study participants will be compensated on an hourly basis for their time.
